Why Kind iVF?

Who is eligible?

We have three specific criteria at Kind iVF:

* Be aged 37 or under

Statistics show that women in this age group are most likely to respond best to IVF. Women over 37, when natural fertility begins to decline, often need more personalised treatment.

* Have a BMI of 30 or less

BMI is a shorthand calculation based on height and bodyweight. Women with a BMI over 30 are not suitable for Kind iVF because of a greater likelihood of treatment complexities.

* Have a good ovarian reserve

Ovarian reserve is a technical term to describe the number of early eggs in the ovary. It is often used as an indicator of fertility. Women with a very high or very low ovarian reserve often respond unpredictably to treatment and will need more specialist care. During your first appointment with us we will perform a blood test and a scan to determine if you are suitable for Kind iVF.





What packages do you offer?

We offer three different packages that meet the needs of those who are accepted on to the programme:

Kind iVF £2,750

IVF is our most popular package. Kind iVF includes one round of treatment, from start to end, at one all-inclusive price with no further or hidden extras along the way. This package includes treatment throughout the complete IVF cycle, all medication required for ovarian stimulation, a full complement of scans to monitor your progress, egg collection & fresh embryo transfer, and pregnancy blood test & scan. We also include the HFEA license fee, a session of counselling, sedation, and any blood tests.


Kind ICSI £3,850

Around one-third of all cases of infertility can be explained by a biological problem with the male partner, usually in the quality or quantity of sperm cells. In such cases we use a procedure called ICSI, or intracytoplasmic sperm injection, to give the weaker sperm a helping hand to fertilise eggs.

Kindonor £3,850

Kindonor offers treatment on the same terms as standard Kind iVF. The only addition is one vial of sperm from our partners, London Sperm Bank (LSB). Our partners at LSB help our patients with all elements of using donor sperm, including donor matching and ensuring you select the right type of sperm for your treatment. We also take care of the movement of your sperm from the bank to reaching your clinic, taking the stress and paperwork into our hands.

How do I get started?



1. Fertility assessment

This is your first step.

We assess you to ensure you meet the criteria for Kind iVF. This consists of a blood test, scan and semen analysis if you have a male partner.



2. Consultation with a fertility consultant

Following your fertility assessment, you will have an appointment with one of our consultants to discuss the treatment package most suitable for you and confirm your individual treatment plan.



3. Treatment

Your treatment is managed by a specialist nurse who will follow and support your progress throughout the treatment. We begin by stimulating the ovaries, around 10 days later we collect your eggs, fertilise them with sperm, and transfer the resulting embryo back around 5 days later.
